ODCTE Implementation:

Idle Session Time Out

In order to ensure the integrity of ODCTE information assets and provide logical controls stated in section 7.4 of the State Information Security Policies and Procedures Guidelines manual. The ODCTE idle session timeouts are as follows:

Workstation Screen Saver	15 minutes
Novell Netware	None
Groupwise web-based	15 minutes
Groupwise workstation-based	None
Heat	None
VPN Connections**	None
FTP – internal	15 minutes
FTP – external	15 minutes
BlackBoard	None
Cold Fusion	_____
Perception	120 minutes
Perception Enterprise Manager	60 minutes
Lotus Notes***	None

*Due to obsolescence, scheduled removal, limited use and hardware and software limitations, a mainframe session does not timeout. ODCTE relies on the workstation screen saver timeout or user workstation lock to secure a mainframe terminal session.

**Idle Session timeouts are not implemented in the current version of OPENVPN at this time. VPN sessions do not timeout.

***The current version of Lotus Notes is unable to set an idle session timeout parameter. Idle sessions are terminated nightly when the server reboots.
